

South Ayrshire Partnership

The Nursery operates in partnership with South Ayrshire Council and adheres to their Admissions Policy. South Ayrshire Council is committed to the provision of quality pre-school provision. Free nursery education places are available for all 3 and 4 year olds living in South Ayrshire.

In general a free part-time place provides 5 x 2½ hours per week of free pre-school education. If you wish fewer than 5 sessions a week we are happy to discuss your requirements with you.

Funding is administered by South Ayrshire Council and Wellington School apply for funding on your behalf.

Funding for children in their ante pre-school year becomes available as follows:

Birthdays between 01 Mar 2007 and 31 Aug 2007, funded place commences Aug 2010.

Birthdays between 01 Sept 2007 and 31 Dec 2007, funded place commences Jan 2011.

Birthdays between 01 Jan 2008 and 28 Feb 2008, funded place commences Easter 2011.

Wellington School Nursery offers facilities out with free part-time places and additional fees are payable for this service.

NURSERY INFORMATION



Wellington School has a large, thriving Nursery located within Drumley House.

The nursery offers a wide range of educational experience and care for children from the age of three years upwards.

The Nursery is managed by the Head of Nursery, Mrs. Nancy Allan, who is an experienced teacher. She is assisted by a team of seven Nursery Nurses all of whom are qualified and experienced in providing pre-school education and care.

The nursery opening hours are from 8.15am until 5.30pm each day during term time. We provide a stimulating educational programme with learning firmly based on play during each morning, with wrap around care available. The Nursery follows National Curricular Guidelines for children aged between three and five years and our aims are set out in this leaflet.



Aims:

The school has a general set of aims, which apply at all stages. The specific aims of the Nursery are set within this context:

- To provide a coherent pre-school learning experience, based within a play context, for children in their pre-school and ante pre-school years which will enable them to progress to Primary 1 with confidence and ease.
- To seek to develop the individual potential of each pupil working carefully with parents.
- To provide a stimulating, supportive, secure and well resourced learning environment.
- To promote at all times the self-confidence and self-esteem of the child.
- To assist children to become more independent and to think for themselves.
- To teach children to care for their environment and to be aware of the needs of others.

These aims will form the basis of the curriculum.
